Notification Srinagar, the **26**th **October, 2017**

SRO **460** .- Whereas, in terms of clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, a notification SRO 73 of 2017 dated 23.02.2017 was published in Government Gazette dated 27th April, 2017 whereby the proposal for revising the minimum rates of wages was issued for inviting objections/suggestions from the persons likely to be affected, within a period of 02 months;

Whereas, in pursuance to said notification, 3 number of objections/suggestions were received by the department, within the stipulated period of 02 months. The same were placed before the State Advisory Board for consultation and subsequent recommendations of State Advisory Board were taken into the consideration by the Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Act No. XI of 1948), the Government of Jammu and Kashmir, after consulting the State Advisory Board constituted under the Act, hereby revise the minimum rates of wages in respect of the scheduled employments shown in Annexure 'A' as under:

| Category | Minimum Wages Per Day (in Rs) |
|-----------------------------|---|
| Un-Skilled | 225 |
| Skilled | 350 |
| Highly Skilled | 400 |
| Administrative/Ministerial/ | 325 |
| | Un-Skilled Skilled Highly Skilled |

The guiding definitions of Un-skilled, Skilled and Highly Skilled works and classification of works thereof, are only illustrative/indicative in nature and not exhaustive, and are given in Annexure 'B'.

However, wages earned before the issuance of this notification by now declassified "Semi-skilled workers" shall be protected and continued to be paid as per the rates, which they are receiving.

This notification shall come into force with effect from 1st November, 2017.

Annexure 'B'

Definitions

- (i) "Unskilled Work" means work which involves simple operations requiring little or no skill or experience on the job:
- (ii) "Skilled Work" means work which involves skill or competence acquired through experience on the job or through training as an apprentice in a technical or vocational institute and the performance of which calls for initiative and judgement;
- (iii) "Highly Skilled Work" means work which calls for a degree of perfection and full competence in the performance of certain tasks including clerical work acquired through intensive technical or professional training or practical work experience for certain reasonable period and also requires of an worker to assume full responsibility for the judgement or decision involved in the execution of the tasks;

Note: Above definitions are not absolute and are intended to act only as a guide.
